Conference themes for proposals:

Understanding the role of interpersonal skills in fostering student engagement and trust in the tutoring process

6. Tutoring and academic success: retention and dropout prevention

Strategies to improve academic outcomes, reduce dropout rates, and promote student persistence in Higher Education

7. The future of tutoring in Higher Education: trends and challenges

Predicting emerging trends in tutoring methods and discussing their implications for student learning and professional development

Submission guidelines:

Each participant can submit up to one paper and one poster.

Posters and communications can be submitted in Portuguese or English. The presentation, however, must be delivered in both languages.

Each submission must include the name(s) of the author(s), their institutional affiliation and the email contact of the corresponding author.

Submitted abstracts should be between 250-300 words.

The structure of abstracts relating to empirical studies should be as follows: introduction and objectives, method, results and conclusion. Each proposal should include 3 to 5 keywords.







Authors should indicate their order of preference for the presentation format of their work (oral communication or poster), and the Scientific Committee will make the final decision on this.

The submission of scientific papers implies the authors' consent to cede the exclusive right to publish and disseminate the content of the proposal by the means deemed appropriate by the Congress Organising Committee.

Communications will last 15 minutes. Posters will be displayed during the day of the conference with a time slot in the programme for discussion of the papers.

Authors will be notified of the acceptance of proposals by 16 May 2025.

There is a possibility that the work will be published. More concrete information will follow soon.

Proposals must be sent here by 9 May 2025.
